In year 9 we have several students who have now accumulated 500 ACE points since starting GWA and will be presented with our first Platinum badges – a fantastic achievement. Other updates this week:

- Oxbridge Applicants We always aim high here, and I'm delighted to report that some of our highest attaining students have now had their UCAS forms sent in fact over 10% of year 13 have applied to either Oxford or Cambridge, which is very high in comparison to most state Sixth Forms. Obviously we are supporting all our year 13 students at this important time, but these applicants had to meet an early deadline of 15th October, and we wish them well!
